Afikomen—"that which comes later"; the piece of matzoh hidden during the seder

Chagigah—roasted egg Charoset—mixture of apples, cinnamon and nuts resembling mortar

Chazeret—the bitter root

2'roa

Feast of Unleavened Bread—a seven-day feast that coincides with Passover, during which no leaven is to be eaten

Haggadah—service book, literally "the telling"

Karpas—greens Maror—ground bitter herb Matzoh—unleavened bread Pesach—Passover Seder—"set order" of Passover service Z'roa—shankbone of a lamb
